Job Shadow Application

Welcome to Idaho Veterinary Hospital! We hope your placement will provide you with a valuable learning experience. There are rules that need to be followed in order for us to continue to provide care and professionalism for our patients while you are observing.

Attire

We are a doctor's office and hospital. To maintain a professional image, we do not wear blue jeans, tee shirts or sweat shirts to work. We ask that you dress accordingly. Cotton twill pants (khaki, blue, etc.) and a button down shirt are preferred. Jeans are acceptable if slacks are not available. Pants should be clean, ironed and hemmed. It is preferable that you do not wear tennis shoes; however, these are acceptable provided they are clean and laced. Alternately, you may wear scrub pants and tops with clean tennis shoes. Please notify us ahead of time if scrubs are needed.

Animal Handling

To provide safety for the patients and you, until you are trained, we ask that you please do not assist, hold or pet any of the patients. Please notify us if you feel weak or faint. This is nothing to be embarrassed about, as it happens to all of us at some time. Please provide us with a contact number in case of emergency.

Confidentiality

All conversations in the hospital are to remain in the hospital. These animals are patients. Client-Patient confidentiality is to be upheld at all times. You may discuss cases with others provided that the animal's name, breed or the client's name is not mentioned.

Placement Hours

For quality purposes we ask that your placement does not require more than 10 hours. These may be spread over a number of days, but we ask that they do not exceed 10 hours or five days. This will ensure that all students interested in placement with our hospital have an opportunity. Idaho Veterinary Hospital is not responsible for recording your hours. You are responsible for keeping a record of your placement hours. A copy of your time sheet will be kept for the hospital's records.

Requirements

You are required to bring pen, paper and twenty questions to ask the doctors or staff. This is a learning experience please use your time wisely. Please ask questions outside of the exam room. Do not interrupt the doctor while speaking to patients. We do allow you to bring a camera but remember our client's information is confidential.
